

What is RRI?

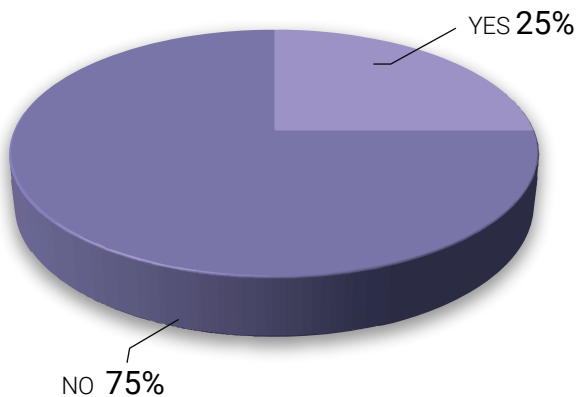
RRI (Responsible Research and Innovation) is an approach consisting of different societal actors (researchers, policy makers, civil society organisations, individual citizens, businesses, etc.) working together throughout the entire research and innovation cycle with the intention to attain better alignment of both processes and outcomes with the values, needs and expectations of society. It comprises 5 key elements: Science Education, Open Access, Gender Equality, Public Engagement and Ethics.

Metodologia

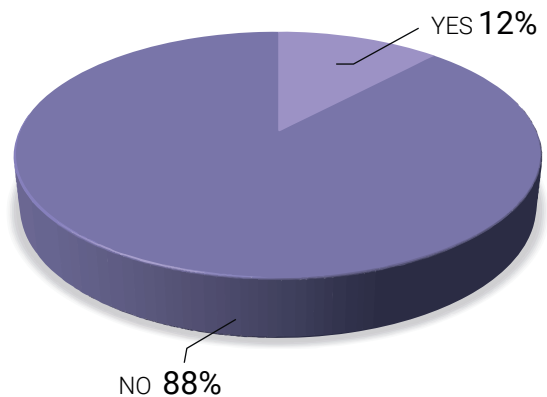
In July 2023, the corporate websites of the 12 Catalan universities and of 59 Catalan research centres (CERCA and CSIC) were analysed to find whether they had a specific section about RRI or, otherwise, a specific section on any of the 5 RRI key elements.

In the analysis only corporate websites were considered, as they are the main informative resource on the universities' and research centres' activity.

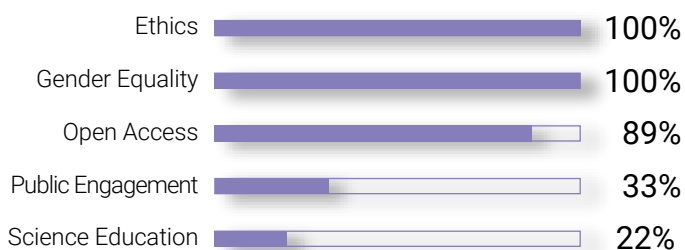
Universities having an RRI specific section on their corporate website
